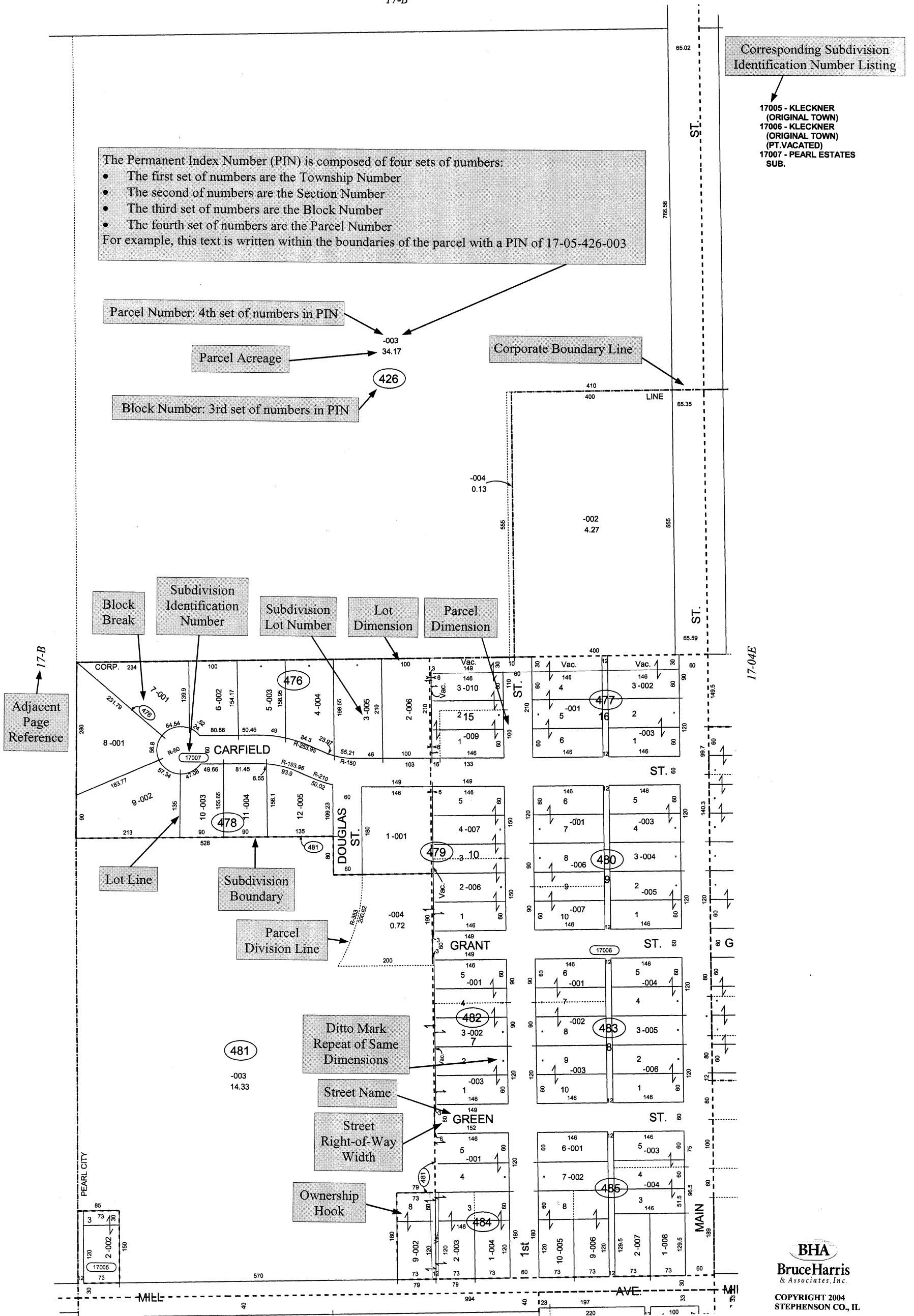


# How to Read the Parcel Atlas

17-B



The Permanent Index Number (PIN) is composed of four sets of numbers:

- The first set of numbers are the Township Number
- The second of numbers are the Section Number
- The third set of numbers are the Block Number
- The fourth set of numbers are the Parcel Number

For example, this text is written within the boundaries of the parcel with a PIN of 17-05-426-003
